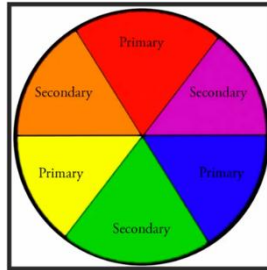
Colour

Key knowledge

Drawing - A simple window can help focus looking and can be helpful when drawing. Items closer to the front of a picture will be bigger and the further back in the picture the smaller the size.

Painting - Artists draw grids to help them to enlarge a painting or drawing.

3D - A natural form is an object found in nature that has not been changed

Key vocabulary

Media	Media is the material used by an artist
Line	A line is a mark made by a drawing tool.
Shape	Shapes are spaces that are created when a line reconnects with itself
Space	The area between objects
Composition	the way visual elements of a work of art are arranged for overall effect
Sculpture	A sculpture is an art form made in three-dimension.
