Key knowledge

The mainstream Christian belief is that Jesus' death was a **sacrifice** s a price he paid to save people from their sins and bring them back to God.

Christians remember Jesus' death and resurrection throughout the year, particularly through the celebration of **communion**.

Communion is celebrated in Christian churches using the symbols of bread (Jesus' body) and wine (Jesus' blood), reminding them of Jesus' sacrifice.

Some Christians follow Jesus' example to the point of dying s becoming a martyr.
