see through	clear

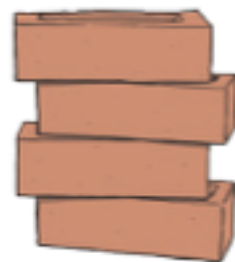

Key knowledge

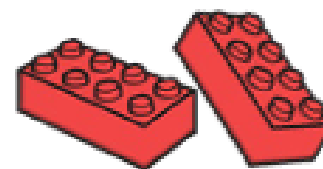
- All objects are made from one or more materials.
