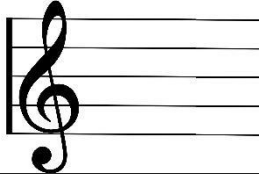
Key knowledge - Notation

- Pitch is represented on the staff.
- A treble clef is used for high-pitched instruments, e.g. recorders, glockenspiels.
- Notes are grouped into beats.

Key Knowledge - Listening

Understanding that different genres of music have specific identifiable features. For example, Reggae is in 4/4 time, is identified through off beats, (emphasis on beats 2 and 4) and specific instruments e.g. timbale.

Key vocabulary

recorder	a simple wind instrument without keys, held vertically and played by blowing air through a shaped mouthpiece against a sharp edge		grouped semi-quavers	four $\frac{1}{4}$ beat notes (adding up to one beat)	
crotchet	a one beat note		treble clef	a symbol showing that the notes following will be high in pitch	
paired quavers	two $\frac{1}{2}$ beat notes (adding up to one beat)		treble clef notes		G, A, B, C, D
