



Welcome to Rapid Reading!

Rapid Reading is a collection of finely levelled fiction and non-fiction books around topics and themes that your children will love. The Rapid Reading books are available as printed books and online. The online world offers an extra layer of motivation and confidence-building, with read-to-me and read/record functions, cool animated characters that support the reader with instruction and feedback, plus online assessment and reporting data that helps you keep children moving at exactly the right pace for them.



With dyslexia friendly features approved by the British Dyslexia Association, and proven to more than double pupils' progress in reading, Rapid is a reading intervention programme that you can trust to really work.

Using the Rapid online pupil world with your child

The Rapid pupil world is the place that your child will log into to read books, complete interactive activities and access rewards. They earn rewards by completing the books and activities that their teacher has allocated to them. They can also have text read to them and record themselves reading.

If you have access to an internet connection, your child can log into the Rapid pupil world at home with their personal login. They can do so via a computer or tablet. Your child's teacher may give them a login reminder bookmark to keep at home, or in their bookbag, so that they have the information they need to access the pupil world from home.

Logging into the pupil world

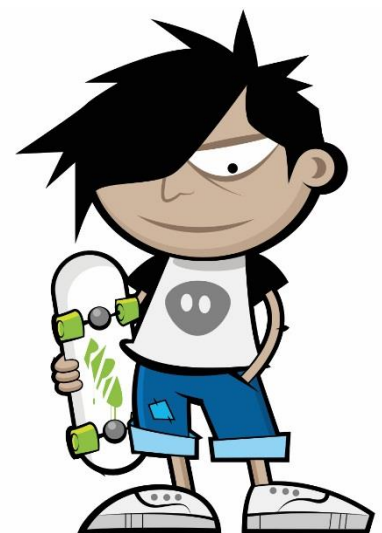
The Rapid pupil world is powered by a website called ActiveLearn. To log into the pupil world, your child will need to:

1. Go to **www.activelearnprimary.co.uk**
2. Enter their login details and click "Log in".

Once your child has logged in, they'll arrive at the Pupil Home. Children can personalise their home screen by choosing a world. The worlds differ depending on key stage but include Race World, Skate World and Future World.

"My Stuff"

This is where children can see the books their teacher has allocated to them. They can see here how many coins each book is worth before completing it.





“My Rewards”

'My Rewards' is where your child can go to select their rewards after completing allocated books and activities. They can also customise avatars, decorate a tree house, play games and more. The more books your child completes, the more rewards they can unlock and buy.



Using the Rapid print books with your child

Occasionally, your child may bring home a printed copy of a Rapid book. The print copies of the Rapid books each contain 2 texts to read, 1 fiction and 1 non-fiction. At Stages 7-9 the books also contain plays and poetry.

Within the print books, you'll find a clearly laid out 'Before Reading' page which helps you introduce the book to your child and identifies any 'tricky' words which appear in the text. At the end of each text is an 'After Reading' page which has comprehension questions to ask your child as well as some 'Super Speller' words for your child to practise.
